Dear Sir,

I am asked by Bosnian Government to submit to you this appeal. There is a great shortage of medical professionals in the besieged pockets in Eastern Bosnia, such as Gorazde, Zepa and Srebrenica. I have just received their requests in order to meet their needs in medical specialities as follows :

1. Gorazde - general surgeon, orthopaedic surgeon, anaesthesiologist, ophthalmologist, radiologist, RTG-technician, psychiatrist, physiotherapist ;
2. Zepa - general surgeon, anaesthesiologist, gynecologist, pediatrician, ophthalmologist, radiologist, RTG-technician, physiotherapist ;
3. Srebrenica - general surgeon, orthopaedic surgeon, anaesthesiologist, ophthalmologist, radiologist, RTG technician, psychiatrist, pediatrician, physiotherapist.

This Ministry is unable to send our medical teams to the besieged pockets, because Serbian side does not permit us to do so. We sent to you the same appeal on the 8th of November, 1994.

Your assistance in this issue would be accepted with great appreciation. I look forward to your urgent reply.
