Sirs,

With reference to your letter of 12 February 1995 I would like to express our appreciation of your efforts to alleviate the sufferings of the civilian victims of the conflict in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The Russian Federation is deeply concerned over the continued impediments to the deliveries of relief aid to those in need in BiH by whomsoever committed.

The Security Council has been deeply seized of this matter and with our active participation issued a number of Presidential Statements in this regard condemning obstruction of humanitarian convoys and calling upon all parties to facilitate unhindered flow of humanitarian assistance. The Council is going to keep the situation in this field under review on a constant basis.
