i am just copying the info of unmo - if i have the same opinion.

1. unhcr convoy with 20,000 combat rations, 15,000 l water 36,000 l diesel, toilets and cleaning material is coming this afternoon. mladic assured that the convoy would be acceptable so there should be no problem with yellow bridge.
2. the un medical convoy with our patients is moving now to tuzla with special escort of bsa personel with personal instructions from mladic for security.
3. the number of departed ref is about 10,000 by now. there should be another 20,000 - 25,000 to be transported more. bsa might be able to transport them all today and start with the ones inside tomorrow, 4,000 - 5,000 approx. after that dutch batt will be transported. no details about this transport yet.
4. the number of bih soldiers that are taken by the bsa is not yet known but mladic told unmo that the bih are having several hundreds of dead soldiers in the area of the bandeara triangle. he also asked the comm of unprofor to contact the bih and to inform them that it is not the intention of the general to kill any more soldiers of bih. they only have to surrender and hand their weapons. col acamovic is a special rep of mladic who is in charge from now on.

voila stef,

this is unmo saying and sending out.

maybe the figure of the ref still here is a bit high.

i am still going up and down to the camp to transport sick people and to bring necessary medications. also plastic sheeting i have given for making sun shelter.

on the spot un doctors are doing triage. they have a water truck there and start giving water and juice and if necessary ors.

most of the new patients are hysteric reactions or invalids.

still no children with severe diarrhoea.

i had one horrible experience - one bsa came with one man and his baby. the man had nobody to take care for the baby. so i had to separate the baby from the crying father while the bsa took the father with him.

there are rumours in the camp that in the back of the camp there are dead bodies. bsa is ok with it, if i would go with unmo, but they dont want to give any guarantee for security.

anyway i think i should not go - too risky, not confirmed, not clear where the dead bodies are. what is your opinion?

local medical staff is just returning from bratunac and tell us, that the first 33 patients are still in bratunac and tisca. so they are not gone to tuzla.

thank you very much for your supporting faxes.

somebody needs urgently the telex so i stop here.

send me some feed back. i am trying again by radio.
